IJK - SUPPLEMENTARY MATERIALS SELECTION AND ADOPTION

Supplementary materials are defined as any instructional materials other than textbooks and required curriculum materials including, but not limited to, books, periodicals, newspapers, pictures, diagrams, maps, charts, slides, filmstrips, films, records, audiotapes, videotapes, and computer programs. Responsibility for the selection and approval of supplementary materials shall rest with teachers, departments, and administrators at the building level, using recommendations from curriculum specialists, IIC, and library media specialists. Teachers are encouraged to use a wide range of learning aids, provided the expense incurred in purchasing these aids remains a building-level expense or is charged to students as authorized by Board Policy [JQ](#).
