BPR 4.1 - Unity of Control

Policy Type: Board-Principal Relationship
Policy No.: BPR 4.1
Policy Title: Unity of Control
Monitoring: Frequency—Annual as reflected in the Board Calendar

Only directives of a quorum of the Board are binding on the Principal (also known as School Director)..

1. All such directives must be appropriately recorded in Board meeting minutes.
2. Decisions, directions or instructions from individual Board members, officers, committees or liaisons are not binding on the Principal/School Director or staff except in rare instances when the Board has specifically authorized such exercise of authority.
3. In the case of Board members, committees or liaisons requesting information or assistance without Board authorization, the Principal/School Director may refuse such requests that require, in the Principal's/School Director's opinion, a material amount of staff time or funds or are disruptive.
