BPR 4.1 - Unity of Control

Policy Type:Board-Principal RelationshipPolicy No.:BPR 4.1Policy Title:Unity of ControlMonitoring:Frequency—Annual as reflected in the Board Calendar

Only directives of a quorum of the Board are binding on the Principal (also known as School Director).

- 1. All such directives must be appropriately recorded in Board meeting minutes.
- 2. Decisions, directions or instructions from individual Board members, officers, committees or liaisons are not binding on the Principal/School Director or staff except in rare instances when the Board has specifically authorized such exercise of authority.
- 3. In the case of Board members, committees or liaisons requesting information or assistance without Board authorization, the Principal/School Director may refuse such requests that require, in the Principal's/School Director's opinion, a material amount of staff time or funds or are disruptive.
