



School Policies

CF - SCHOOL BUILDING ADMINISTRATION

The School Director shall act as the chief administrative officer of the school. They shall be responsible for and shall have authority over the actions of the students, employees, and visitors while on school property or within a managed virtual learning environment.

The School Director shall be responsible for achieving the long- and short-range educational objectives of the school as they pertain to students and staff.

The School Director, in consensus with the faculty, shall be responsible for management of the school's education program inspired by Waldorf education and sustainability, and consistent with applicable laws, district policies, and regulations.

The School Director, in consensus with the faculty, shall have the authority to make school rules consistent with school policies that are deemed necessary to ensure the opportunity for students to take full advantage of the educational experiences provided.
